

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given of a public hearing to be held on July 19, 2016 at 9:00 a.m., in the Okaloosa County Administration Building, 1250 N Eglin Pkwy, Shalimar, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, to consider the adoption of an ordinance entitled as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OKALOOSA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 20, ARTICLE II OF THE OKALOOSA COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES AND ORDINANCE 89-23 AS SUBSEQUENTLY AMENDED, RELATING TO THE TOURIST DEVELOPMENT PLAN AND USE OF TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX REVENUE; MAKING FINDINGS; AMENDING THE COUNTY'S TOURIST DEVELOPMENT PLAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE FUNDING OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES NEEDED TO ADDRESS TOURISM IMPACTS WITHIN THE SUB-COUNTY TAXING DISTRICT; AMENDING THE COSTS OF ADMINISTERING COLLECTIONS; MODIFYING THE AUTHORIZED USES OF TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX REVENUES; UPDATING REVENUE PROJECTIONS AND ALLOCATIONS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
