Okaloosa Expecting Severe Weather Tonight Residents Can Register for Code Red Weather Warnings

The National Weather Service is issuing warnings in our area for severe weather from approximately 6 PM tonight until 2 AM. Numerous storms with wind gusts are expected, as well as possible hail and tornadoes. **Residents in Okaloosa County can register for the Code Red Weather Warnings System, and be called if weather is impacting your neighborhood.** To register online, follow this link: https://public.coderedweb.com/cne/en-US/AB421EC3518B or simply select the Code Red icon at the bottom of our home page at www.okaloosafl.com.

Many residents are registered for Code Red Weather Warnings in Okaloosa County. However, many still have not signed up for this great, free service and **The Code Red Weather Warning system will physically call you if there are severe weather warnings in your area of Okaloosa County, and works on TDD/TTY phones for the hearing impaired.** All residents who wish to be notified for tornado, severe thunderstorm, and flash flood warnings simply add their contact information. In the event of a tornado, this notification could save your life. If you do not have internet access please contact Okaloosa County Public Safety at 850-651-7150 and someone will assist you.
