Okaloosa County Public Notice of Contained Sewage Spill

Okaloosa County, Fla. — Okaloosa County has experienced an estimated 100 gallon sewage spill, which occurred in the county right-of-way of Martin Luther King Boulevard, 400 feet north of Freedom Way. Due to the quick response of Okaloosa Water and Sewer Department, and the small size and containment of the spill, there are no required advisories for this location. Okaloosa County Water and Sewer (OCWS) representatives have completed cleanup actions. To clarify, sewage did <u>not</u> get into any drinking water sources or bodies of waters.

Okaloosa County Water and Sewer (OCWS) has notified the proper authorities. This notice is in response to Emergency Rule 62ER16-1: Public Notice of Pollution.
