Okaloosa County Commission Plans Executive Session

The Okaloosa County Commission will conduct an Executive Session prior to its regularly scheduled Board meeting on Tuesday, February 2, 2016 in the County Commission Conference Room of the Okaloosa County Administrative Building to discuss ongoing litigation.
