The user is advised to be aware that for flood insurance or regulatory determinations, or for supporting an application for a Letter of Map Change (LOMC), only the official and latest FEMA FIRM and Flood Insurance Study (FIS) report should be consulted. Also, all elevation data submitted in support of a LOMC application must be certified by a licensed land surveyor, engineer, or architect. The NFWFMD, FEMA, its agents, and partners shall not be held responsible for the misuse or misinterpretation of the information presented in this portal.
