## JOINT PRESS RELEASE: OKALOOSA COUNTY PUBLIC NOTICE OF CONTAINED SEWAGE SPILL

**Okaloosa County, Fla. –** Okaloosa County has experienced an estimated 100-gallon sewage spill, which occurred in the county right-of-way of Martin Luther King Boulevard, 400 feet north of Freedom Way. **Due to the quick response of Okaloosa Water and Sewer Department, and the small size and containment of the spill, there are no required advisories for this location.** Okaloosa County Water and Sewer (OCWS) representatives have completed cleanup actions. To clarify, **sewage did not get into any drinking water sources or bodies of water.**

Okaloosa County Water and Sewer (OCWS) has notified the proper authorities. This notice is the required final update in response to Emergency Rule 62ER16-1: Public Notice of Pollution.
