

Paramedics or EMTs are often the first to arrive when there has been a medical emergency.




The person who answers the phone when you dial 9-1-1 is called a dispatcher. He or she is trained to help in any kind of emergency.



OUR UNITED STATES





Start Here




Here's a maze that's a bit more of a challenge than the last.

When someone is hurt during a traffic accident, you should dial 9-1-1 and tell the dispatcher exactly what has happened.

MAZE CRAZE

Help the 9-1-1 dispatcher direct the **Start Here** ambulance, police and firetruck to your house! See how quickly you can do it, every second counts!



If you ever need to dial 9-1-1, be sure to speak clearly and calmly. When there is an emergency, every second counts! Answer all of the questions the dispatcher asks the best you can.





**There are many reasons to dial 9-1-1, but this is not one of them.
Remember, 9-1-1 is for actual emergencies only!**



Police officers often respond to calls made to 9-1-1.



Remember that 9-1-1 is for emergencies only. False alarms cost authorities valuable time that could be better spent saving a life!



Firefighters are just one of the groups of people who respond to a 9-1-1 call.



**If a little brother or sister eats something that makes them sick,
let an adult know. A call to 9-1-1 may be needed!**
