## **Okaloosa County Commission to Hold Executive Session**

The Okaloosa County Commission will conduct an Executive Session on January 10, 2012 subject to the Board's approval at their regularly scheduled meeting on that date. The Executive Session will be immediately following the regular Board of County Commission meeting on Tuesday, January 10, 2012 in the County Commission Ante room in the Crestview Courthouse to discuss ongoing litigation. The Executive Session will begin at approximately 8:00 pm.

After the meeting is convened, the Board will go into closed session pursuant to Section 286.011(8), Florida Statutes. The subject matter of the executive session is: 1) Okaloosa County vs. Shalimar Village and 2) the Beach Renourishment litigations. The discussions in this session shall be confined to settlement negotiations or strategy sessions related to litigation expenditures as to these litigation matters. The session will be recorded by a certified court reporter. The meeting will last approximately one hour and will be attended by Chairman Don Amunds, Vice-Chairman Dave Parisot, and Commissioners, James Campbell, Wayne Harris and Bill Roberts; County Administrator James Curry, County Attorney John Dowd, and Special Counsel, Greg Stewart, Esq.

Following the closed session, the Board will reconvene in open session in the Board Chambers so that the Board can take action, if necessary. After which, Chairman Amunds will announce the termination of the executive session.
