Okaloosa County Commission Plans Executive Session

Pending approval of the Board of County Commissioners at its regular meeting, the Okaloosa County Commission will conduct an Executive Session on May 1, 2012 in the Board anteroom on the first floor of the Okaloosa County Courthouse. The Executive Session will immediately following the regular Board of County Commission meeting and will be limited to pending litigation.

After the meeting is convened, the Board will go into closed session pursuant to Section 286.011(8), Florida Statutes. The subject matter of the executive session is: 1) Beach Renourishment and 2) the Department of Juvenile Justice litigations. The discussions in this session shall be confined to settlement negotiations or strategy sessions related to litigation expenditures as to these litigation matters. The session will be recorded by a certified court reporter. The meeting will last approximately one hour and will be attended by Chairman Don Amunds, Vice-Chairman Dave Parisot, and Commissioners, James Campbell, Wayne Harris and Bill Roberts; County Administrator James Curry, County Attorney John Dowd, and Special Counsel, Greg Stewart, Esq.

Following the closed session, the Board will reconvene in open session in the Board Chambers so that the Board can take action, if necessary. After which, Chairman Amunds will announce the termination of the executive session.
