Hurricane Preparedness Program at EOC May 29 *Learn Local Procedures & Resources to Prepare for a Storm*

A free hurricane preparedness program is being offered at the Okaloosa Emergency Operations Center on Tuesday, May 29, from 5:30 – 8:00 p.m. Okaloosa Emergency Management and UF Extension will focus on preparation methods for the upcoming hurricane season in the presentation, “Preparing for a Storm.”

Topics include homeowner’s insurance, storm-resilient landscapes, home preparation, managing pets during a storm, clean up safety and special information for military families.
