WAVE Bus Service to New Okaloosa Co. Courthouse Annex Extension Begins Oct. 1

Beginning Monday, October 1, 2012, the Okaloosa County Public Transit System, WAVE bus Route 5, will offer limited bus service to the CHOICE High School/Technical Center (Vo-Tech), New Okaloosa County Courthouse Annex Extension and Water & Sewer Building on Lewis Turner Boulevard.
