Okaloosa County Commission Plans Executive Session

The Okaloosa County Commission will conduct an **Executive Session immediately following the Board of County Commission meeting on Tuesday, June 4, 2013** in the County Commission Chambers located in the Crestview Courthouse, to discuss ongoing litigation. The Executive Session is estimated to begin at 11:00 a.m. The Crestview Courthouse is located at 101 E. James Lee Boulevard in Crestview.

After the meeting is convened, the Board will go into closed session pursuant to Section 286.011(8), Florida Statutes. The subject matter of the executive session is Okaloosa County v. Meigs Family Trust litigation. The discussions in this session shall be confined to settlement negotiations or strategy sessions related to litigation expenditures as to these litigation matters. The session will be recorded by a certified court reporter. The meeting will last approximately one hour and will be attended by Chairman Don Amunds, Vice-Chairman Dave Parisot, and Commissioners Kelly Windes, Wayne Harris and Nathan Boyles; County Administrator Ernie Padgett, County Attorney John Dowd, and Special Counsel, Greg Stewart, Esq.

Following the closed session, the Board will reconvene in open session in the Board Chambers so that the Board can take action, if necessary. After which, Chairman Amunds will announce the termination of the executive session.
