Beach Restoration Project Complete – Ribbon Cutting May 17, 10 AM *Vice Chairman Commissioner Dave Parisot to Speak*

Western Destin's beach restoration project will celebrate completion on May 17, at 10:00 a.m. at Jetty East Condominiums. The completed beach restoration project cost \$7.5 million, which was funded through the resort tax collections or bed taxes and a Municipal Benefit Tax Unit (MSBU). Twenty three turtles were rescued in the process, including 11 Kemp's Ridleys endangered species.
