Volunteer Sought for Okaloosa Co. Electrical Board

Okaloosa County's Department of Growth Management is seeking a volunteer to serve as consumer representative for the Electrical Trade Industry Board. Industry Boards include the Construction, Electrical, Plumbing and Mechanical Competency Boards.

The trade industry boards review qualifications for competency cards, hear complaints, and consider disciplinary action against license holders. The positions are designed to give consumers a voice on issues related to those trades, have been in existence for 10+ years, and trade industry boards are required by local ordinance.

Consumer representatives must be an Okaloosa County resident, and board representatives must have no involvement in that particular industry. Typically, boards meet once a month in the Fort Walton Beach Water and Sewer building; however, meetings are dependent on applications.
