The Resources and Ecosystems Sustainability, Tourist Opportunities and Revived Economies (RESTORE) Act was enacted by the United States Congress in direct response to the Deep Horizon Oil Spill. On March 5, 2013, the Okaloosa Board of County Commissioners adopted a Resolution to establish the Okaloosa RESTORE Act Advisory Committee for the purpose of assisting the Board in determining valid projects, and also providing assistance in determining the projects that qualify under the RESTORE Act.
