Okaloosa County Commission Plans Executive Session

The Okaloosa County Commission will conduct an Executive Session immediately prior to the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners on Tuesday, March 18, 2014 in the County Commission Meeting Room on the third floor of the Water & Sewer Administration Building to discuss ongoing litigation. The Executive Session is estimated to begin at 8:00 a.m.

After the meeting is convened, the Board will go into closed session pursuant to Section 286.011(8), Florida Statutes. The subject matter of the executive session is the Sandman L.L.C. v. Don Amunds, et. al. litigation. The discussions in this session shall be confined to settlement negotiations or strategy sessions related to litigation expenditures as to this litigation matter. The session will be recorded by a certified court reporter. The meeting will last approximately thirty (30) minutes and will be attended by Chairman Kelly Windes, Vice-Chairman Nathan Boyles, and Commissioners Don Amunds, Wayne Harris and Dave Parisot, County Administrator Ernie Padgett, County Attorney John Dowd, and Special Counsel, Greg Stewart, Esq.

Following the closed session, the Board will reconvene in open session in the Board Chambers so that the Board can take action, if necessary. At which time, Chairman Windes will announce the termination of the executive session.
