Okaloosa Transit WAVE Fixed Route Normal Service Today; Begin at Noon Wednesday, January 29; Paratransit Operates Tues. & Wed

Okaloosa County Transit WAVE fixed route will operate normal service hours Tuesday, January 28, 2014. WAVE service will begin at noon Wednesday, January 29, 2014 and will resume normal operations. PARATRANSIT service will operate Tuesday, January 28, 2014 and Wednesday, January 29, 2014. Wednesday paratransit clients with early morning appointments should expect delays.

Okaloosa Board of County Commissioners' government offices will be closing at 3:00 p.m. today and are scheduled to reopen on Thursday, January 30, at 8:00 a.m. Northwest Florida Regional Airport closed earlier today. Okaloosa County Public Safety and Public Works will continue to monitor and react to weather conditions and emergencies.
