Commissioner Nathan Boyles to Discuss Storm Damage & Recovery July 17th

Okaloosa County Commissioner Nathan Boyles invites citizens to a meeting to discuss recent storm damage on July 17, at 5:30 p.m. The meeting will be held at the Okaloosa County (Crestview) Courthouse, where Public Works staff will also be available to provide updates and answer questions. “I encourage anyone impacted by damaged or failing infrastructure to attend the meeting, and share your ideas and concerns,” says Vice Chairman Nathan Boyles, Okaloosa County Commission.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has approved a 14-day extension for storm and flood survivors to register for disaster assistance. The deadline to register is now **Monday, July 21**. Residents affected by the storms and flooding from April 28 to May 6 can register online at DisasterAssistance.gov or on a smart phone at m.fema.gov.
