Okaloosa County Commission Plans Executive Session

The Okaloosa County Commission will conduct an Executive Session immediately prior to the scheduled workshop and the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners on Tuesday, April 21, 2015 in the County Commission Meeting Room on the third floor of the Water & Sewer Administration Building to discuss ongoing litigation. The Executive Session is estimated to begin at 5:00 p.m. and to last for 30 minutes.

After the meeting is convened, the Board will go into closed session pursuant to Section 286.011(8), Florida Statutes. The subject matter of the executive session is Okaloosa County v. LaGrange Aero, Inc. et. al. litigation. The discussions in this session shall be confined to settlement negotiations or strategy sessions related to litigation expenditures as to this litigation matter. The session will be recorded by a certified court reporter. The meeting will last approximately thirty (30) minutes and will be attended by Chairman Nathan Boyles, Vice-Chairman Kelly Windes, and Commissioners Wayne Harris, Carolyn Ketchel and Trey Goodwin, County Administrator John Hofstad, County Attorney Greg Stewart, and the certified court reporter.

Following the closed session, the Board will reconvene in open session in the Board Chambers so that the Board can take action during its regular scheduled meeting, if necessary. At which time, Chairman Boyles will announce the termination of the executive session.
