Okaloosa County Seeks Members for Crab Island Committee

Shalimar – On February 19th the Okaloosa County Commissioners approved the creation of a citizens committee to review the newly adopted Floating Structures ordinance that regulate commercial vending on Crab Island to provide recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners for possible enhancements.

The committee, which will be made up of seven representatives from the community, is looking for volunteers to serve as representatives for the seats reserved for livery operators (upland business owners who rents jet skis and pontoon boats), recreational users of Crab Island and commercial vendors who service Crab Island.
