Incident at Bob Sikes Airport

Bob Sikes Airport – An Aero Commander-560 twin engine aircraft attempting to land at Bob Sikes Airport suffered damage to its landing gear and skidded off the runway. There were no injuries resulting from the incident.

The North Okaloosa Fire District, Airport staff, EMS and the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office- Airport Security Unit and the Fixed Base Operator- Emerald Coast Aviation responded to the incident.

Crews are working to remove the damaged aircraft from the airfield. The runway is closed until the aircraft is removed and inspections are completed. Upon completion, the airfield will be reopened.

The Federal Aviation Administration has been notified.
