Okaloosa County Commission Plans Executive Session

The Okaloosa County Commission will conduct an Executive Session immediately prior to the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners on Tuesday, December 20, 2016. The Executive Session will be held in the County Commission Meeting Room located at the Okaloosa County Administrative Building, to discuss ongoing litigation. The Executive Session is estimated to begin at 5:30 p.m. and to last for an estimated 30 minutes.

After opening the public meeting, the Board shall go into closed session pursuant to Section 286.011(8), Florida Statutes. The subject matters of the executive session are the cases *The Moore Law Firm v. Okaloosa County, Florida*. The discussions in this session shall be confined to settlement negotiations or strategy sessions related to litigation expenditures as to these litigation matters. The session will be recorded by a certified court reporter. The meeting will last approximately thirty (30) minutes and will be attended by Chairman Kelly Windes, Vice-Chairman Carolyn Ketchel, Commissioners Nathan Boyles, Trey Goodwin and Graham Fountain, County Administrator John Hofstad, County Attorney Greg Stewart, and the certified court reporter.

Following the closed session, the Board will reconvene in open session in the Board Chambers so that the Board can take action, if necessary. At which time, Chairman Windes will announce the termination of the executive session.
