Submittal	Red	uirements	Checklist:

Installation/Abandonment Notification Form. This form comes from the Escambia County Health Department and must be signed by them.
Proof of property ownership. This can be a recorded deed, closing statement or property tax information.
Two sets of construction plans. The construction plans must be certified, signed and sealed by a Florida Registered Design Professional (Architect or Engineer). These must also have the fire department approval prior to submittal to our department.

NOTE: If the pollutant storage tank is located in the northern portion of Okaloosa County, **three sets** of construction plans are required. Fire review will be performed in the Growth Management Department.

Effective 10-1-2010, Pollutant Storage Tanks being removed and not being replaced, will require a permit from our department. Permit fee is \$25.00 plus a \$60.00 base fee plus add a 3% (Surcharge Fee) to the combined total or a minimum charge of \$4.00, whichever is greater. You will need to contact Escambia County Health Department and the Fire Department for approval. If the job is located in the North end of Okaloosa County, the Okaloosa County Fire Prevention & Life Safety Ordinance 07-38 also requires a tank removal permit be purchased and our Fire Inspector witness each tank removal. This fee is \$75.00 for each location.

Contact the Escambia County Health Department before submitting to our Department.
